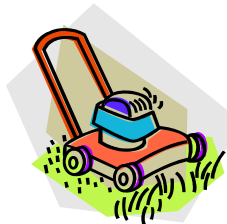

# Borrowing Rules

1. Only residents or property owners of the City of Peoria over the age of 18 are eligible to borrow tools from the City of Peoria's Tool Lending Center.
2. Residents must fill out a borrower's agreement and verification of the borrower's identity and residency. Verification is accomplished by presenting a valid photo ID and a utility bill, both displaying a City of Peoria address. Additionally, the borrower must sign a form of Waiver and Indemnification which is located on the borrower's agreement.
3. The borrower agrees that the City of Peoria Tool Lending Center is not responsible for any manufacturing defects in quality of workmanship or materials inherent in any borrowed tools.
4. The borrower agrees that if any borrowed tool becomes unsafe or in a state of disrepair, they will immediately discontinue use of the tool and notify the City of Peoria of the issue on return, if not earlier.
5. All tools borrowed are to be returned at the specified place, date and time.
6. All items are first come, first served.
7. City of Peoria retains the right to refuse the loan of any item to any person for any reason whatsoever.
8. One renewal is possible if arranged ahead of time with City of Peoria staff. Phone calling is only effective if you are able to get through and personally speak to a member of our staff. "Day-of" renewals may be possible; however, borrowers must be prepared to return all items by the original specified place, date and time. The City of Peoria reserves the right to refuse or limit renewals, and will do so based on demand.
9. Items are to be returned in the same condition as they were issued, barring normal wear and tear. All items must be returned clean. The borrower agrees to pay for the loss of or damage to any item and further agrees to accept City of Peoria's staff assessment of condition of items and to further agree to City of Peoria's staff's assessment of fair restitution for damage, dirtiness, delinquency and/or loss of items in part or in total. This restitution amount could equal replacement cost of the item plus handling and processing fees.
10. When tools are not returned by the specified date and time, the City of Peoria will issue an overdue notice. If the tools are not returned after the notice has been sent, appropriate steps will be taken to retrieve them including collection agency and/or legal action. City of Peoria may replace severely delinquent tools, holding borrower responsible for full replacement cost plus applicable handling fees. Future borrowing would not be allowed.
11. Maximum of 3 powered tools can be checked out at one time.

## Hours of Operation

Equipment may be checked out on Thursdays between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. and equipment must be returned on Mondays between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.



**Pick up and return is by appointment only. You must call 623-773-7667 between the hours of 7:00 am and 6:00 pm to make an appointment.**
