This project consists of constructing a new roadway for use by truck and local traffic along the Agua Fria River between the intersections of 112th Avenue & Rose Garden Lane and 107th Avenue & Pinnacle Peak Road. The new roadway will include a travel lane and a paved shoulder in each direction. The primary purpose of the new roadway is to reduce existing truck traffic along Beardsley Road.

As part of the project, the intersection of 107th Avenue and Pinnacle Peak Road will be widened to allow for future eastbound dual left turn lanes. A new traffic signal will also be installed at the intersection.

Impacts to Residents

Utility Impacts: No utility impacts to residents are anticipated with the construction of this project. Water, sewer, telephone, and television service should not be affected by the work.

Private Property Impacts: Impacts are expected to private properties within the proposed roadway alignment. No other impacts are anticipated for this project.

Traffic Impacts: Construction will occur within the intersections of 112th Avenue & Rose Garden Lane and 107th Avenue & Pinnacle Peak Road and, as a result, traffic restrictions will be encountered. The extent of these impacts will be further defined by the Contractor before and

during construction. Access will be maintained to businesses, public streets, school buses, garbage trucks, etc. but there will be inconveniences due to the work.

Right-of-Way Acquisition: Right-of-way will be purchased along the proposed roadway and along 107th Avenue from private owners and from Arizona State Lands.

Dust & Noise: Heavy construction equipment will be performing excavation, grading, and paving of new asphalt and sidewalk.

Trash Pickup & School Bus Routes: No interruption of services is anticipated during construction of the project.
