Cailet has worked with Valley of the Sun United Way in the past to prepare “hunger backpacks” for school kids who depend on free/reduced lunches and cannot always get their meals due to holidays or when school is out of session. Committee liked this idea. Matt mentioned certain high schools such as Peoria and Kellis are Title 1 and need the help. Their feeder schools would also need help. Matt suggested reaching out to school’s student council or government bodies to assist. Cailet volunteered to call Valley of the Sun United Way, Taylor volunteered to call St. Mary’s Food Bank and Maylee will call Heart Pantry to gather more information on their programs and how the committee can help. A motion was made by Cailet Popelier to call local vendors and gather more detail about helping feed hungry children and to hold another meeting next week to finalize a proper plan; Maylee Acosta seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.
