POLICY


The Shift Battalion Chiefs will be responsible for the ongoing management of MCS for their respective shifts. Minimally an annual report will be made detailing the set of skills evaluated, who was in attendance, date and times. Any company performing below standards will be given a date in which they will be retested.

The Training Division will assist in any training aides and supplies necessary for MCS.

Documentation

It will be the responsibility of the Shift Battalion Chief to document the set of skills evaluated, who was in attendance, date and times. The documentation will be forwarded to the Training Division to be filed. It will also be the Shift Battalion Chiefs responsibility that the training hours are entered into the computer data base system.
