3. **Authorization to Hold Executive Session:**

NEW BUSINESS:

4. New Membership Application:

Kristen Venditte, Board Secretary, advised the Board of the new memberships for Dylan Dominguez, Tyler Indelicato, Xavier Reyes, Andre Jackson, Gaetano Florio and Joshua Kielman (all hired as Police Recruits) to participate in the Public Safety Personnel Retirement System as a Tier 3 member with pre-existing conditions. *Special Note: Per PSPRS statutes, contributions to PSPRS will not start until the 91st day.*

Board Member Josh Champion moved to accept the new membership applications of the six (6) Police Recruits listed above. Motion seconded by Board Member Norm Bacon. Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.

5. New Membership Application:

Board Member Norm Bacon moved to accept Scott Cunningham's new membership application. Motion seconded by Board Member Josh Champion. Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.

Kristen Venditte, Board Secretary, advised the Board of Kristopher Babros' membership application to participate in the Public Safety Personnel Retirement System as a Tier 3 member with pre-existing conditions. **Special Note:** *Kristopher was hired as a lateral Police Officer. He had already served his 90 day waiting period with previous PSPRS employer so he will not have a new waiting period for contributions and will start contributing to PSPRS as of his hire date with the City of Peoria.*

Board Member Norm Bacon moved to accept Kristopher Babros' new membership application. Motion seconded by Board Member Josh Champion. Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.

7. Application to Retire from DROP:

Kristen Venditte, Board Secretary, advised the Board that Garry Coulter has elected to retire from the Deferred Retirement Option Program (DROP) effective May 30, 2019.

Board Member Josh Champion moved to accept Garry Coulter's DROP retirement application with an effective date of May 30, 2019. Motion seconded by Board Member Norm Bacon. Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.
