TEAM ROSTERS

Roster forms are due at the time of registration. Rosters may not contain less than nine or more than 18 players. After registration, players may be added or deleted with the site supervisor in the league's roster book up until the beginning of their fifth game.

Additions to the roster must be made with the site supervisor before the new player participates in a game. A player must play in at least four regular season games to be eligible for tournament play. Use of ineligible players will result in forfeiture of game and may result in team's expulsion from the adult baseball league.


LEAGUE FORMAT

Doubleheaders are played once a week for a total of 10 regular season games followed by a single elimination tournament.

League play tentatively begins August 2, 2009 for the Sunday division and August 8, 2009 for the Saturday divisions. Games are held at 8 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. and will consist of seven innings or two hours and 15 minutes, whichever comes first.

Fields are prepped before each set of doubleheaders and two umpires and four baseballs are provided for each game.

Tournament play begins the week after the conclusion of the regular season. Tournament seeds are determined by the final division standings at the end of the regular season. The tournament champion from each division will be awarded a \$300 discount off the registration fee for the following season.

Each division has a maximum of eight teams.


All players must be 18 years of age or older to participate.

DIVISION CRITERIA

The league does not accept individual player registrations, only team registrations. Divisions are not restricted by age other than the minimum of 18 years old. Teams may evaluate their skill level and submit to play in either division. Final determination of a team's division assignment will reside solely with the community services department.

"A" Division: Adult players of any age and is considered a higher level of competition.

"B" Division: Adult players of any age and is considered a lower level of competition.



REGISTRATION DATES AND FEE

Returning team registration: July 13, 2009 8am — 5pm
Teams must retain 60% of their Spring '09 roster to qualify

New team registration: July 14 — 17, 2009 8am — 5pm

Registrations are accepted on a first come, first served basis in accordance to the above guidelines. Teams must present a roster form and fee at the time of registration. No exceptions.

Team registration fee: \$1,300.00 (11 game guarantee)
