Community Services Department 2009 High School Fall League

This league has been developed to provide opportunity for 'B-Team' or JV/Frosh players with limited varsity experience an opportunity for off-season instruction through participation in organized league play.

The league consists of an 8-game guarantee. Teams will participate in a 7-game regular season followed by an end-of-season single elimination tournament. All Games will be played at the Peoria Sports Complex practice fields on Tuesday & Wednesday afternoons at 4:00 PM and Saturday morning and afternoons throughout the day. Saturday games can be single games or doubleheaders. Teams registering must be prepared to play on any and all of the days listed above.

League play tentatively begins September 1, 2009. Games will consist of seven innings or two hours, whichever comes first. Tournament play begins the week after the conclusion of the regular season. Tournament seeds are determined by the final division standings at the end of the regular season.

This league is based on the philosophy of recreation and exercise for all individuals involved. The league enforces a code of conduct to promote sportsmanlike behavior and a safe, fun, friendly environment for all participants, including managers, players, fans, umpires and staff.
