

ROADWORK PLANNED

The City of Peoria Streets Division has awarded a contract to International Surfacing Systems (ISS) to install rubber chip seal on the following streets in your community:

- **Jomax Road**, 92nd to 95th Avenues
- **92nd Avenue**, Happy Valley Road to Jomax Road
- **93rd Avenue**, Happy Valley Road to Jomax Road
- **Prickly Pear Trail**, 92nd to 94th Avenues
- **95th Avenue**, Briles Road to Jomax Road
- **Briles Road**, 94th to 95th Avenues
- **94th Avenue**, Prickly Pear Trail to Briles Road
- **95th Avenue**, Happy Valley Road to Saddlehorn Road
- **93rd Avenue**, Villa Lindo Road to Happy Valley Road
- **Hatfield Road**, 91st to 93rd Avenues
- **Hatfield Road**, 89th to 91st Avenues
- **89th Avenue**, Villa Lindo Road to Hatfield Road
- **Pinnacle Peak Road**, 77th to 81st Avenues
- **77th Avenue**, Pinnacle Peak Road to Avenida del Sol
- **79th Avenue**, Pinnacle Peak Road to Avenida del Sol
- **Camino del Oro**, 78th to 79th Avenues
- **Villa Lindo Road**, 67th to 70th Avenues
- **72nd Avenue**, Calle Lejos to Hatfield Road
- **Mariposa Grande Lane**, 67th to 70th Avenues
- **Avenida del Sol**, 67th to 70th Avenues
- **Camino del Oro**, 67th to 70th Avenues
- **70th Avenue**, Camino del Oro to Calle Lejos

This project will help reduce dust on these currently unpaved roads.

WHEN & WHERE

The construction effort will get underway in September, 2004; the project is slated for completion in early November. Construction work hours will be 6:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday; hours may vary with seasonal changes. The contractor will work weekends, if needed.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

City of Peoria construction crews first will install aggregate base course (ABC) on the roadways to provide a solid foundation for the chip seal. Next, the streets will be graded so ISS crews can install the chip seal in October. Please note that this project does not address long-term drainage or paving requirements in the area – solely dust abatement.

This improvement effort does not include chipping driveways between the new street and property driveways. Property owners or residents may obtain a permit from the City of Peoria to independently extend or construct concrete or asphalt driveways within public right-of-way and connect to the newly chipped street. Please call 623-773-7600 for permit application information.

RED, YELLOW, GREEN: GO!

During the chip seal installation, on-street parking will not be allowed from 6:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Please obey the onsite flagpersons as they direct you through the construction. In addition, give yourself plenty of time to get where you are going as there may be traffic delays. The contractor will notify you via a door hanger in advance when the chip seal is to occur.

DUST ABATEMENT EXPLAINED

This environmental air quality dust abatement project will improve dirt roads identified in Peoria's PM-10 Roads Program in compliance with federal EPA mandates and Maricopa County's air quality plan.
