

On The Jobsite

APS, Southwest Gas, Cox Communications, Qwest and the City of Peoria's water department completed their relocations! SRP now is relocating its irrigation and power lines in the intersection. Expect restrictions January through February. All of the utility relocations are expected to be finished in February 2009. The improvements to the intersection by ADOT will begin in May-June 2009.



About The Project

The City of Peoria, in partnership with the Arizona Department of Transportation, will widen the 91st Avenue and Olive Avenue intersection and provide additional right and left turn lanes. Improvements within the project limits will include paving, curb, storm drain, gutter, driveways, medians, street lighting, sidewalks, pedestrian access ramps, landscaping and relocating the traffic signal. Safety First

Do not go into the construction work area until the project is finished. Thank you for your assistance and cooperation.

When Driving Around

During the utility relocation phase, expect traffic lane restrictions. However, access always will be maintained for residents, businesses and emergency vehicles. Please allow yourself extra time to get where you are going, as there may be traffic delays. Also, do not move barricades or traffic signs as they are in place for your safety.
