SPECIAL NOTICE

The City of Peoria would like to apologize for the traffic restrictions and late notice for closures of Williams Road and Deer Valley Road at the Lake Pleasant Parkway. In addition, there are numerous projects in your area that will be restricting traffic. The planned coordination and timing of road closures and restrictions does not always happen because individual project schedules are moved or delayed for various unforeseen reasons. Please have patience as we improve our City.

UPDATED INFORMATION FOR EXISTING ROAD RESTRICTIONS


- 107th Avenue is restricted to one lane in each direction between Quail Avenue and Burnett Road until **summer 2008**. This closure is for City drainage improvements.
- Rose Garden Lane is closed between 104th Drive and 107th Avenue until **spring 2008**. Beardsley Road may be used as an alternate route. This is for City storm drain improvements.
- 107th Lane is closed between Rose Garden Lane and Harmony Lane until **early January 2008**. This is required for City storm drain improvements.
- 109th Avenue is closed between Rose Garden Lane and Harmony Lane until **early December 2008**. This is required for City storm drain improvements.
- Pinnacle Peak Road is closed between the 107th Avenue alignment and Lake Pleasant Road until **early November 2007**. Avenida del Sol may be used as an alternate route.
- Lake Pleasant Parkway has traffic lane restrictions between Williams Road and Dynamite Boulevard Alignment and from 83rd and Union Hills to 95th and Lake Pleasant Parkway until **December 2007** for median landscaping.

NEW ROAD RESTRICTIONS

- Deer Valley Road is closed between 104th Drive and Lake Pleasant Parkway through **December 2007**. Beardsley Road, Happy Valley Road or 107th Avenue may be used as alternate routes. This closure is required to construct the southbound lanes of the lake Pleasant parkway.
- Williams Road is closed between 102nd Drive and Lake Pleasant Parkway through **December 2007**. Beardsley Road, Happy Valley Road or 107th Avenue may be used as alternate routes. This closure is required to construct the southbound lanes of the new Lake Pleasant parkway
- 95th Avenue is restricted to only one lane with flaggers between Deanna Drive and Lake Pleasant Parkway. Initially, this restriction will be in place, daily, from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. through **October 2007**. After October 2007, the restrictions will be in place through **Spring 2008**. This is required for City storm drain improvements.
- Expect traffic lane restrictions at the Pinnacle Peak Road and 91st Avenue intersection from **October 2007 to March 2008**. There will be FCD storm drain improvements and a County signal installation project. The intersection will not be completely closed during this time. Please expect turn lane restrictions and at least one lane each direction..

NEW ROAD RESTRICTIONS continued...

- 89th Avenue will be closed between Williams Road and Deer Valley Road from **October to December 2007** for storm drain improvements. Access for local residents will be provided. Through traffic should use 91st Avenue.
- Expect traffic lane restrictions at the 89th Avenue and Deer Valley Road intersection from **October until December 2007** for storm drain improvements.
- 83rd Avenue to 91st Avenue on Pinnacle Peak Road will have restrictions for FCD storm drain improvements from **October 2007 to October 2008**. Please expect turn lane restrictions and delays.
- 83rd Avenue will be restricted between Deer Valley Road and Calle Lejos from **October 2007 to spring 2008** for storm drain improvements.
