



Pool Rental Policies

We want your rental experience to be as smooth and enjoyable as possible. There are a few policies that you and your guests may want to become more familiar with prior to your event. Thank you for your cooperation!

All floatation devices must be U.S. Coast Guard approved. No floaties, inflatable flotation devices, or unapproved flotation suits are allowed in the pool. We do have approved lifejackets available at no charge if needed.

Goggles and t-shirts are not allowed on the slide or off the diving boards. We do, however, allow rash guards and other water-appropriate shirts on both.

There is only one rider allowed on the slide at a time.

The slide height requirement is enforced at 42". Lifeguards may assist a child but cannot continue to "catch" them. They must be able to recover and exit on their own.

We ask that you please do not bring glass containers or bottles into the facility.

Lifeguards indicate an emergency with three whistle blasts. If three whistle blasts are heard, please exit the pool immediately and wait for further instructions.

Other important rules:

- There is no running anywhere in the facility.
- Diving is not allowed anywhere but the diving well.
- Jumping in is permitted in the lap pool but we ask that participants sit down and slide in the shallower play pools.
