



City of Peoria Youth Sports Participant Code of Conduct

1. Demonstrate great sportsmanship towards all players and coaches.

- I will never lay a hand upon, shove, strike, or physically attack an opposing player or coach.
- I will always do my best and encourage my teammates to give their best.
- I will respect my opponents as well as my own teammates.

2. Be respectful and courteous to all players, staff, officials, and spectators.

- I will not argue or question the referees or staff at any time.
- I will never verbally abuse, attack, or use vulgar language in any manner directed towards others.
- I will not harass, bully, or make fun of other players, coaches, referees, or parents.
- I will not use unnecessary, rough tactics during game play.

3. Be respectful of my volunteer coach.

- I will be a part of my team and will not exclude myself from drills, warm ups, etc.
- I will do my best to attend all practices and games.
- I will let my coach know in advance if I'm going to miss a practice or game.

4. Be respectful of all City of Peoria equipment and property.

- I will not abuse, vandalize, or steal City of Peoria or anyone's property.

5. Know the rules of the league and abide by them.

- I will ask my coach or a staff member if I have questions about the rules.

Enforcement of Code of Conduct

Enforcement of the code of conduct will vary based on severity of the issues and complaints. Immediate suspension or removal from the league can occur without a written or verbal warning.

Any participant who is ejected from a City of Peoria Youth Sports event must leave the facility immediately with a parent or guardian. However, if a parent/guardian is not present, the participant must leave the playing area.

Any participant who is removed from league due to violation of code of conduct will not be eligible for a refund.
