

NEW RIVER TRAIL CONNECTIONS COMING SOON

The New River Trail will soon extend beyond its northern terminus at Williams Road all the way to Happy Valley Road thanks to the combined efforts of the City of Peoria and the City of Glendale.

The City of Glendale in 2013 applied for and received federal funding to design and construct a new 10-foot-wide multi-use path along the east bank of New River between Williams Road and the drainage channel at Patrick Lane, just south of Pinnacle Peak Road. As roughly 30 percent of the project lies in Peoria, the city entered into an agreement with Glendale to share the costs of the local match for design and construction.

The project will include the installation of several low-flow crossings, as well as a new concrete slab bridge and handrail over the existing drainage channel.

The Arizona Department of Transportation is administering the project because it is federally funded. Construction is expected to begin this fall and wrap up this winter.

The City of Peoria is fully responsible for a related project that will construct missing trail segments along the east bank of the New River between Pinnacle Peak Road and Happy Valley Road. Design is now underway and is expected to be complete by summer 2019. Construction is expected to begin in fiscal year 2020.
