Peoria Community Assistance Resource Center organizations services information:

Ability360 - Programs to empower people with all disabilities to take personal responsibility so they may achieve or continue independent lifestyles within the community. Our programs include Community Integration, ADA services, Advocacy, This is my life, peer support, sports and fitness center, home care services, Benefits to Work AZ/ work incentives consulting, employment services, Theater 360 and Livability.

Adelante – Eligibility specialist to assist with AHCCCS forms and other available options.

ARIZONA@WORK - Provides job placement, skills assessments, job training, career counseling and resume development for 18-24 yr. olds.
Access Point for Adults: This program provides workforce development assistance to Maricopa county job seekers and employers. Access Points extend the reach of the tools and knowledge of workforce development into the community.

Benevilla – Benevilla’s Family Resource Center (FRC) is dedicated to helping parents prepare their children (0-5 years) to start school healthy and ready to succeed. We provide a variety of services including Community Services Information and Referrals, AHCCCS, DES Applications, and more.

Bloom365 - Provides healthy relationship education in K-12 schools, trains teens as peer educators/advocates and offers crisis counseling, interventions and ongoing support to teens experiencing dating abuse or sexual violence.

Child Crisis Arizona - Provides emergency shelter, foster care, adoption, counseling, early education, home visitation and parenting support services to Arizona’s most vulnerable children and families.

Foundation for Senior Living - Provides In-home care, adult day care, affordable housing and senior centers.

JAG - Assists youth to remain in school and acquire the academic, personal and leadership skills required for success after graduation.

Marc Community Services - Provides educational, therapeutic, rehabilitation and social services to children and adults with developmental/physical disabilities and behavioral health challenges. At this center, they will work with this demographic that is also homeless.

St. Vincent de Paul – Utility assistance to low income individuals and families.

Stepping Up for Seniors - Helping seniors who require care, but who lack the family support or financial resources to provide needed care for themselves.

Sun Health Wellness – Memory Care Navigator programs provide personal and professional guidance for those living with dementia, as well as family members and caregivers coping with the emotional, psychological and physical effects of memory loss.

WIC@ Adelante – Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (**WIC**) provides Federal grants to States for supplemental foods, health care referrals and nutrition education for low-income pregnant, breastfeeding and non-breastfeeding postpartum women, and to infants and children up to age five who are found to be at nutritional risk.
