

## WHAT'S IN YOUR WATER?

Do you know what is in your drinking water? The city of Peoria takes great pride in ensuring citizens are being provided the best possible drinking water by treating, testing and delivering safe water. The city's superior technology and dedicated staff work daily to deliver exceptional value per gallon. You can view this information in full detail through the City of Peoria's 2018 Water Quality Report. The report will be ready for distribution by June 1, 2019. It includes helpful information about the city's water supply and the steps that are being taken to ensure the drinking water meets federal, state and local quality standards. It also includes information about conserving water, which is important for residents of the desert southwest.

The information included in the report is important not only for residents, but tenants, students and employees of the city who receive water. Be sure to let any water users of the city know where they can obtain an electronic copy of the report, or you can provide it to them.

## HIKING SAFETY FOR YOU AND YOUR PETS

As the weather heats up, it is hard not to enjoy all of the beautiful trails our city has to offer. If you head out for a hike, be sure to pack plenty of water, wear sunscreen and reapply on long hikes.

As you are on the trails be aware of the following signs of heat stress: thirst, muscle cramps, excessive sweating, nausea, and light-headedness. If you are not feeling well, find a place to cool down and drink water. If you bring your pets with you on a hike, remember they do not sweat like humans. Dogs expel heat through panting, be aware of them panting more than usual, being lethargic, unwilling to move or disoriented. If you notice your pet displaying these symptoms, move them out of the heat and cool them down with water.

## PEORIA POLICE YOUTH CITIZEN ACADEMY TO KICK OFF IN JUNE

If you have a child at home who is interested in the exciting field of law enforcement, consider the Peoria Police Department's Youth Citizen Police Academy this summer. The purpose of the program is to introduce students to the multifaceted world of law enforcement through weekly sessions that take place across four weeks. The classes begin on June 3 and conclude on June 27. Classes meet daily from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. or from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.

On the final day of class, students will be able to participate in investigating a mock crime scene. Each crime scene will be prepared especially for them. Through the hands on interaction, students will have the opportunity to build valuable relationships throughout the department with officers and civilian staff.

Interested students must be attending a Peoria school or live in Peoria and be entering 7th or 8th grade in the fall of 2019. Participation is free thanks to a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice.

Peoria's AMPM summer camp is a fun, affordable way to keep your kids busy this summer for only \$27 a day or \$105 for the week. Lunch and basic field trips are included in the fees, four premium trips available for an additional cost per trip. The summer camp runs May 28 through July 31 at Paseo Verde, Parkridge, Cotton Boll, Sundance, Zuni Hills, Sunset Heights and Cheyenne Elementary Schools. Children between the ages of 5 and 14 can participate in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) projects, as well as many supervised on-site activities.
