This includes more shaded seats, a children's splash and play zone—the first of its kind in the Valley, and a private, luxury room available for up to 200 guests that offers a VIP experience with a private patio overlooking the diamond.

Baseball fans will enjoy the action and excitement of watching pre-season baseball with multiple food and beverage options that range from a Burger Bar to various specialty items like the jalapeno-wrapped foot-long hot dog, mac n' cheese hot dog, family-size souvenir helmet nachos, and street tacos.

With many unique amenities designed to keep the entire family entertained, this year we are also proud to continue our discount program for Peoria residents called Resident Rewards. This offer allows Peoria residents a chance to save 25% on tickets and receive free parking. There are many tools available to city of Peoria residents that will help answer questions, solve problems or provide useful information. The online HOA Interactive Map is a tool that is easy to use and provides residents with important information about their neighborhood homeowners association (HOA).

The interactive map allows Peoria residents to easily locate their neighborhood HOA and its contact information. By clicking on the map or typing your address in the search bar, residents will receive useful HOA information, such as property type and community manager information, as well as an address, website and phone number. This valuable information makes it easy for residents to report concerns and find out about upcoming meetings.

Additionally, if you are considering buying a home in Peoria, it can be a useful device in helping to determine if your potential location has an HOA.
