



Proclamation

Whereas, the Civil Rights Act of 1968, commonly known as the Federal Fair Housing Act, and the Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988, prohibit discrimination in the sale, rental, leasing and financing of housing or land to be used for the construction of housing; and

Whereas, these acts prohibit discrimination in the construction of housing and in the provision of brokerage services on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, handicap, familial status or national origin; and

Whereas, the 1968 and 1988 Federal Housing Acts declare that it is a national policy to ensure equal opportunities in housing for every person; and

Whereas, April has traditionally been designated as Fair Housing Month in the United States of America.

Now, Therefore, I, Cathy Carlát, Mayor of the City of Peoria, in the State of Arizona, do hereby proclaim the month of April 2020, as

“Fair Housing Month”

in Peoria and in doing so, encourage our citizens to recognize and show their support for the letter and spirit of the Fair Housing Acts.
