



Title: Library Assistant II

FLSA Status: (Non-Exempt)

BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

The purpose of this position is to perform a variety of moderate paraprofessional library work in support of library operations. This is accomplished by performing a variety of clerical work and customer support including circulation and public assistance. Other duties may include completing related tasks as assigned.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Additionally, please be aware of the legend below when referring to the physical demands of each essential function.

#	Code	Essential Functions
1	M	Greets and assists patrons at the circulation desk and provides customer service. Checks out books and other library materials and issues library cards. Assess items coming in for damage. Checks in library materials and sorts to appropriate cart or placing in transit. Places book holds, and processes lost books.
2	M	Performs general clerical work such as typing, data entry, copy materials, and maintains files and records. Sorts library materials by alphabetizing or by using the Dewey Decimal System.
3	S	Assists Library Assistant I in the operation of library circulation procedures and policies.
4	L	Assists patrons with the online public access catalog and other programs.
5	L	Oversees and trains volunteers on mending, displays, calling holds, and shelving as required.



JOB REQUIREMENTS:

-Description of Minimum Job Requirements	
Experience	1-2 years experience. Moderate previous experience required in the same or similar previous positions. The job requires a good working knowledge of common and uncommon techniques, methods, practices, procedures, use of forms, routines, etc., of a moderate to complex nature.
Education	High school graduation or equivalency.
Technical Skill	Basic technical skills. Work requires the use of standard, routine technical skills appropriate to the work environment of the organization.
Physical Demands	Work requires moderate physical exertion. Forces exerted are equivalent to lifting between 10 and 25 pounds. Job requirements for manual dexterity or physical manipulation are also moderate. The need for physical stamina and endurance is of some significance. The degree of physical strain produced on the job is moderately taxing, and is fatiguing. Work could involve a considerable amount of walking, standing, a confining or tiring work position, or constant periods of sitting in one position where the freedom does not exist to walk about.
Contacts	Contacts are necessary to perform the job as work involves internal and external contacts for the purpose of providing guidance, instruction or technical advice or for the purpose of explaining business matters by interpreting organizational policy. Improper handling would cause problems in relationships. Work involves occasional contact with people who are upset, uncooperative or have difficulty communicating their requirements and/or an occasional requirement to communicate information that people do not want to hear or may find upsetting.
Responsibility	May show another employee how to perform a task or may have some lead authority over one or more people for a short period of time through the year. May train replacement and/or co-worker in own job functions.
Accountability	Decision/action situations have a limited impact on the organization. Errors are usually detected by the organization. Errors are usually detected by a systematic verification and review. Errors may result in some work flow disruption, repetition of work or have limited impact on resources within a department.
Environment	Exposure to some undesirable or unpleasant environmental characteristics. Physical environment is generally safe and there is minimal health risk. No safety equipment or unusual precautions are required.
Safety	Work involves few, if any, duties that if incorrectly performed could present a safety risk to others.
Reading	Intermediate - Ability to read papers, periodicals, journals, manuals, dictionaries, thesauruses, and encyclopedias. Ordinarily, such education is obtained in high school up to college. However, it may be obtained from experience and self-study.
Math	Basic - Ability to perform the four basic arithmetic operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication, division). Ordinarily, such education is obtained in elementary school up to high school. However, it may be obtained from experience and self-study.
Writing	Basic - Ability to write simple sentences containing subject, verb, and object, and/or series of numbers, names, and addresses. Ordinarily, such education is obtained in elementary school up to high school. However, it may be obtained from experience and self-study.
