

Adopt-A-Street Program

Adopt-A-Street is a rewarding opportunity that allows residents to support the City's Anti-Litter Program. At no cost to the participant(s), this program offers the satisfaction of making a contribution to the community. The Adopt-A-Street program requires organizations to make a two year commitment to pick up litter along a designated one mile stretch of roadway, three times a year. Participants of this program must be eleven years of age or older and minors must be accompanied by an adult during all community service efforts performed.

How it works:

An organization, group or family may apply to adopt a one-mile section of roadway.

Throughout the adoption, participants will have the responsibility of picking up litter within their specified mile of roadway, a minimum of three times a year over a two-year commitment.

In return, the City of Peoria will post two prominent signs recognizing the participant or participants.

How to get started:

- 3) Download and Complete Participation Forms for the Adopt-A-Street Program, on the Streets Division Home Page
