# Why Should You Install a High Efficiency Toilet?

High efficiency toilets or HET's are the latest generation of toilets you'll find in the market. They have earned this title by using at least 20% less than the current federal standard of 1.6 gallons. How do toilets perform with such little water? Design advances such as larger traps and improved flushing technologies have brought enhanced performance with less water. Also, many are dual flush toilets meaning they have buttons or levers that allow you to use one option for liquid waste, another for solid waste.

Whether remodeling a bathroom, constructing a new home, or simply replacing an old, leaky toilet that is wasting money and water, installing a WaterSense labeled toilet is a water-efficient option worth considering. ## Toilet Trivia

- Replacing 3.5 gallon toilets with WaterSense labeled toilets can save a household 12,000 gallons of water each year.
- 1.6 gallon low-flow toilets have been shown to reduce toilet water use by 23 to 46 percent.
- An average family of four uses 881 gallons of water per week just by flushing the toilet.
- Americans use more water each day by flushing the toilet than they do by showering or any other activity.
- A running toilet can waste up to 200 gallons of water per day.

# High Efficiency Toilet Rebate Program

## Program Requirements

City of Peoria water customer accounts will be credited up to \$100.00 (limit three per property / account). After installation please submit receipt / invoice with completed application. Remember to keep a copy for yourself!

### Required Feature

Water sense high efficiency toilet must be 1.28 gallons per flush or less. Please feel free to contact the City's water conservation team with any questions about this requirement.

## Rebate Procedure

1. Check your water bill to verify that you are a City of Peoria water or sewer customer.
2. Verify that your home or business was built prior to 1994.
3. Purchase up to three high efficiency toilets.
4. Make sure the receipt / invoice lists the actual cost of the high efficiency toilet, excluding taxes and installation fees.
5. Install your high efficiency toilet(s) or have them installed.
6. Submit completed application with receipt / invoice.
7. It may take up to 1-2 billing cycles for credit to post to your account.
