

Division Criteria &

Skill Level Guidelines

Men's Open – Teams have adult players of any age and any ability level.

Men's Over 30 – Teams have players 30 years old and older. Each team is allowed two (2) age exemption players (under 30). However, these players may not pitch or catch. Players may be of any ability level.
