## TEAM ROSTERS

Roster forms are due at the time of registration. Rosters may not contain less than nine or more than 18 players. All players on a roster must be 18 years of age or older. After registration, players may be added or deleted in the tournament roster book with the site supervisor through the 2nd Wednesday of games only, after which rosters are final. Additions to the roster must be made with the site supervisor before any new player participates in a game. Use of ineligible players in a game will result in forfeiture of game in progress and may result in expulsion from the tournament.

## **TOURNAMENT FORMAT**

The tournament consists of a 5-game guarantee, including 3 pool play games and a single-elimination bracket with a consolation game for teams losing in the first round of bracket play. Schedule will begin on Wednesday, October 6. Each team will play one game a week on Wednesday nights at 7 p.m. and games will consist of 9 innings or no new inning after 3 hours, whichever comes first. Two umpires, four baseballs and an official score sheet will be provided for each game played.

Pool A: Team 1, Team 2, Team 3, Team 4

Pool B: Team 5, Team 6, Team 7, Team 8

Once pool play concludes, teams will be seeded 1 through 8 for the single-elimination bracket, which will also include a consolation game for each team losing in the first round.

## **TOURNAMENT AVAILABILITY**


