

# PEORIA'S INVESTMENT IN PUBLIC SAFETY, OPEN SPACE, PARKS AND RECREATION, AND NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION

*On November 8, 2016, Peoria voters will have the opportunity to decide whether to increase the current sales tax rate by four-tenths of one cent to fund the following public safety, open space, parks and recreation, and neighborhood stabilization needs identified by Peoria citizens.*



## PUBLIC SAFETY

### Alternative Response Vehicles (ARVs)

Purchase two alternative response vehicles to respond to medical emergency calls for service by the Peoria Fire-Medical Department, freeing the bigger trucks for fire needs.

### Lake Pleasant Fire Station

Build a permanent fire station on the west side of Lake Pleasant, reducing response times on the Lake and SR 74.

### Park and Trail Police Rangers


Add four Park and Trail Police Ranger positions to ensure safety of residents at all Peoria parks and trails.

### Two Sworn Police Officers

Two sworn police officers dedicated to neighborhood and business issues.

### One Sworn Police Officer

Add a total of five sworn police officers; dedicate two to neighborhood and business issues, one to senior residents' issues and add two to patrol.



## OPEN SPACE CONSERVATION AND PRESERVATION

### Preservation of Land

Keep specific areas of Peoria's Sonoran Desert undeveloped and open for resident recreation, cultural sites preserved, scenic views unobstructed.

### Sunrise Mountain Preservation

Generally located in the vicinity of 91st Avenue and Happy Valley Road.

### Calderwood Butte Preservation

Generally located in the vicinity of 99th Avenue and the Dynamite Road alignment.

### Prince Mountain Preservation

Generally located in northwest Peoria near the Central Arizona Project Canal and Bullard Avenue alignment.

### Mountain Preserve Trailheads/Trails

Establish and maintain trails for public access for Sunrise Mountain, Calderwood Butte and Prince Mountain.



## RIVER TRAILS

### River Trail Improvements

Develop and maintain Peoria trails for multi-modal (pedestrian, bike, equestrian) access along the New River and Agua Fria rivers.

### River Trails: Central Arizona Project Lake Pleasant Pkwy/67th Ave

Trail System Connections – 3.25 miles along the Central Arizona Project (CAP) from Lake Pleasant Parkway to Sonoran Mountain Ranch.

### River Trails: White Peak/Westland Park to Lake Pleasant Pkwy


Trail System Connections – 6.95 miles along the CAP from White Peak/Westland Park to Lake Pleasant Parkway.

### River Trails: 75th Ave to CAP

Trail System Connections – 3.26 miles along New River from 75th Avenue and Happy Valley Road north to CAP Trail.

### River Trails: Agua Fria-Tierra del Rio to CAP Trail

Trail System Connections – 3.12 miles along Agua Fria River from Tierra del Rio development north to Central Arizona Project Trail.



## RECREATION/PARKS LIBRARIES/AQUATICS

### North Recreation Center

Construct recreation center located at Northern Community Park with wellness, fitness and recreational sports opportunities.

### Neighborhood Parks

Upgrade existing and maturing neighborhood parks.

### Universally Designed Parks and Amenities

Retrofit and design parks, playgrounds and amenities with ease of accessibility for the wide spectrum of human abilities.

### North Community Center - Pinnacle Peak

Construct Community Center in Northern Peoria for community-wide programs and services with an emphasis on meeting the needs of special populations, including those with disabilities.

### Library Services in Northern Peoria

Provide library services located in Northern Peoria.

### Aquatics Facility

Construct year-round aquatics facility to provide recreational sports, wellness and swim lesson programs.

## NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION

### Old Town Improvements

Improvements to designated historical area in Old Town Peoria.

### Shade Initiative

Install shade structures at bus stops and high pedestrian traffic areas.

### Citywide Streetscape

Ensure streetscapes in maturing areas are kept up to standard along the major and arterial roads.
