

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, ARIZONA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE PEORIA CITY CODE (1992) BY AMENDING SECTION 2-21 PERTAINING TO CITY COUNCIL; EX OFFICIO YOUTH MEMBERS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Peoria, Arizona as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2 of the Peoria City Code (1992) is amended by amending Section 2-21 pertaining to City Council; Ex Officio Youth Members as follows:

Sec. 2-21. City Council; Ex Officio Youth Members.

(a) The Mayor in accordance with policies adopted by the Council governing appointments to Boards and Commissions of the City shall appoint a Youth Member as an Ex Officio member of the City Council.

(b) Each year prior to June 30, the City Council Subcommittee on Boards and Commissions Policy and Appointments shall submit to the Mayor recommendations for appointment of two Ex Officio Youth Members of the City Council ~~and two alternates~~. The appointments shall be for a term of One Year commencing upon approval of the appointment by the Mayor and Council.

(c) A Youth Member nominated for a full term may not serve until confirmed by the Council. A Youth Member must be a person who is legally domiciled in this City and attends an educational institution established under the laws of the State of Arizona on a full-time basis. The Youth Member may exercise all rights and privileges of a council member, except the right to vote. The City Manager or his designees shall provide such staff support as the City Manager determines to be necessary and appropriate.

(d) The term of each student member is from August to May of the following year. ~~one year, beginning on July 1~~. The Council by a majority vote may remove the Youth Member. A Youth Member who graduates with six months or less remaining in their term may serve the remainder of the term.


(e) A vacancy in the office of youth member shall be filled as follows:

1. If a vacancy occurs, the office shall be filled for the unexpired term. ~~The Mayor may nominate either of the Alternate Members designated for this position and who may serve the balance of the term upon confirmation by the Council.~~

SECTION 2. Providing for Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision; and such shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 3. Providing an Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective in the manner provided by law.


