Boards and Commissions, and Subcommittees may vote to meet in executive session for the purpose of obtaining legal advice from the City's attorney on any matter listed on an agenda pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3), or for any other matter authorized under A.R.S. § 38-431.03, which has been specifically listed on the meeting agenda identifying the statutory basis for executive session consideration.

Executive Sessions are always preceded by an open meeting per A.R.S. § 38-431.03, and are held in compliance with one or more of the following statutes.

- A.R.S. § 38-431.03.1 - *Personnel matters*
- A.R.S. § 38-431.03.2 - *Records exempt by law from public inspection*
- A.R.S. § 38-431.03.3 - *Legal advice*
- A.R.S. § 38-431.03.4 - *Litigation; contract negotiations; settlement discussions*
- A.R.S. § 38-431.03.5 - *Personnel matters dealing with employee organizations*
- A.R.S. § 38-431.03.6 - *International and interstate negotiations*
- A.R.S. § 38-431.03.7 - *Purchase sale or lease of real property*
