1C MINUTES:

Motion was made by Councilmember Pearson, seconded by Councilmember Rivero, to approve the Subcommittee minutes from the May 2, 2012 meeting and June 6, 2012 meeting. Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously 2 to 0.

NEW BUSINESS:

2R Street Maintenance Program

Maher Hazine, Deputy Director of Public Works-Utilities, provided an overview of the current street maintenance program for the Council Subcommittee on Sustainable Development and Public Services.

Discussion ensued amongst the Council Subcommittee regarding the street maintenance program.

Carlo Leone addressed the City Council Subcommittee on Sustainable Development and Public Services. Mr. Leone expressed concern that cracks in the road should be resurfaced versus filled in. He indicated this method leaves the road aesthetically unpleasing.

Chris Oehl addressed the City Council Subcommittee on Sustainable Development and Public Services. Mr. Oehl expressed concern that the roads near the Scotland Yard community are not being maintained. He explained that the potholes are creating a safety hazard. Additionally, he expressed concern with increased traffic in the area.

Kitty Surface addressed the City Council Subcommittee on Sustainable Development and Public Services. Ms. Surface expressed concern that there are multiple pot holes along the road adjacent to Scotland Yard Park and the rocks are creating a safety hazard to vehicles and pedestrians in the area.

The City Council Council Subcommittee asked staff to follow up on the traffic concerns presented and evaluate the road conditions for the Scotland Yard area directly with Councilman who represent the district.
