



PROJECT #UT00296-BEARDSLEY ROAD TRUNK SEWER REHABILITATION

PROJECT INFORMATION

The City of Peoria awarded a contract to Quest Civil Constructors to rehabilitate and repair defective sewer segments and manholes in the wastewater collection system on Beardsley Road from Lake Pleasant Road west to 107th Avenue. Included in this work is approx. 1500 linear feet of Cured-In-Place-Pipe (CIPP) rehabilitation. This rehab method re-lines the existing sewer with a new material expected to last 50+ years. This requires a full above ground sewer bypass setup to route the wastewater around the sections being re-lined. The bypass piping will be visible to residents (large black pipe) and there may occasionally be some odors where the pumping operation is taking place. We do not expect the odors to impact any residents (homes are too far away). In addition, this work will include rehabilitation of many of the manholes. **Most of the work will occur at night; however, there will be a two week period where daytime work will occur.** During this period, residents and businesses can expect some traffic restrictions where the sewer bypass piping will be set up. Included in this is a left turn restriction into the storage unit area (it will be right in and out only), a left turn restriction onto 104th Drive (right in and out only), and a left turn restriction onto 106th Avenue (right in and out only).

PROJECT LOCATION

The Manhole rehabilitation work will occur near the Bashas driveway just east of Lake Pleasant Road (LPR) and Beardsley Road as well as in the intersection itself. **This work will be done at night to lessen any potential impact on the businesses and residents.** The CIPP process will begin on the west side of the Lake Pleasant Road and Beardsley Road intersection and proceed west approx. 2500 feet (to 106th Avenue).

Daytime hours-6a.m. to 7p.m. (from April 23 to May 4, 2012)

Night hours-7p.m. to 6 a.m.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

The CIPP process, including the bypass setup, will begin on Monday, April 23rd and end on Friday, May 4th. The bypass setup will be removed by this date and daytime traffic restrictions will be gone. Manhole rehab will continue (at night) until mid to late May.
