ARS 16-351.A

Any elector filing any court action challenging the nomination of a candidate... shall do so no later than 5:00pm on the tenth day, excluding weekends and holidays after the last day for filing nomination papers and petitions.

Last day to file a Challenge:

June 13, 2012

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Campaign Literature

***New Requirements

Literature and Advertisement

- ARS 16-912: All literature or advertisement must include “Paid for by (the full name of the committee)” as it appears on the Statement of Organization OR \$500 Threshold Exemption Statement.
 - Any printed material that expressly advocates the election
 - Candidate Signs are exempt from the disclosure if they are paid for by the candidate’s campaign committee.
 - Exemptions: Similar small items (buttons, pens, bumper stickers...) where this disclosure cannot be conveniently printed.

****The disclosure shall be printed clearly and legibly in a conspicuous manner*

- ✓ shall be printed in a font at least 3/32 inches tall (approx: 9pt font)
- ✓ in dark type on a light background
- ✓ surrounded by a dark box

Collecting Funds

Forbidden Contributions

- Candidates, Exploratory Committees, and Committees that give to candidates **CANNOT** accept the following types of contributions:
 - Corporations**
 - Labor Unions
 - Limited Liability Companies
 - Non- U.S. Citizens [2 U.S.C 1441(E) and 441 (F)]
 - An anonymous person or group
 - **NO RAFFLES or PASSING THE HAT**
 - An earmarked contribution
 - **NO GIVING ON SOMEONE ELSE'S BEHALF**
- Candidates and Exploratory Committees cannot give to committees of other candidates.
 - ** Corporations can make Independent Expenditures ****





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Campaign Finance Public Disclosure

What is required?

- **For Committees that have filed a \$500 Threshold Statement**
 - **Campaign Finance Reporting is NOT required**
 - **Until and unless you reach the \$500 Threshold**
 - **Including personal money**
 - **Within 5 days after exceeding the \$500 the committee must file a Statement of Organization (ARS 16-902.01)**
- **For Committees that filed a Statement of Organization**
 - **Reporting of ALL activity for each reporting period**
 - **any contributions received or expenditures made for the entire election cycle – Primary & General combined**

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Treasurer's Duties

ARS 16-904

- **No expenditure may be made for or on behalf of a political committee without the authorization of the treasurer**
- **Maintain all books and records**
 - **Keep all documents for 3 years after the committee has filed a final report showing all disbursements of funds and a termination statement**
- **Obtain the required information for any contributions received**
 - **Occupation & Employer for contributors**
 - **Make at least one effort by written or verbal request**
- **Sign the Campaign Finance Report**
 - **If unavailable the Candidate may sign his or her own report**

- A candidate should keep track of mileage when using their car for campaigning.
- A candidate may list the expense as a candidate loan on Schedule C and pay their self for this expense using schedule D-4 of the campaign Finance Report.
 - Use the Federal Rate at the time of reimbursement
