Peoria Fire Department now Peoria Fire - Medical Department

What's in a name? The Peoria Fire Department has changed its long standing name to more accurately reflect what the Fire Department's operations and its employees are doing more predominantly on a daily basis in today's environment. More than 85% of all calls the Fire Department responds to are medical in nature, and the Fire Department is trying to recognize that shift in service delivery with a name change that more accurately reflects the day to day expectations. At the January 20 City Council meeting, Council approved this new logo and name. Changing the decals on all Fire-Medical Department vehicles will occur over the next couple of years.
