



YEAR IN REVIEW

Pioneer Community Park opens – 83 acres, featuring six lighted dual-use baseball/softball fields with shaded spectator seating and four lighted soccer fields, all capable of accommodating tournament play. The park also has a five acre fishing lake with catch and keep fishing.

Peoria Community Center expansion and remodel - The existing buildings were renovated; 12,000 sq. ft was added with the entire building under one roof structure. The building received LEED Gold certification.



Installed three new public art pieces, "Aureole" by Gordon Huether, "Agrarian Memories" by Joe Tyler, and "On Track" by Kevin Berry



Peoria added 7.5 miles of **bike lanes** (97.5 miles total in city)

Peoria is the first Arizona city to appoint a **youth to City Council** - Youth Council Liaisons, Jacob Jelinek and Thomas Pryor join Mayor and City Council members as non-voting members at the dais.



Trine University began classes in Peoria – Angola, Indiana-based university opened satellite campus.

Maxwell Technologies opened 120,000 square foot facility - global leader in developing, manufacturing and marketing energy storage and power delivery solutions.





DO

- Place items curbside on the day before your scheduled zone.
- Remove or secure appliance doors as a safety precaution.
- Place cacti in sturdy boxes.
- Cut tree limbs into 3-4 feet sections and stack parallel to curb.
- Bag and tie all leaves/grass.

DO NOT

- Do not exceed 10 cubic yards in size (Approx. 6' long x 4' wide x 3' tall). Call for a quote on larger piles.
- Do not place bulk items over sprinklers, cable boxes, near ornamental borders or on grass/desert landscaping. It is the residents' responsibility to maintain landscaping if disturbed by equipment.
- Do not place items within five feet of parked cars, fences, utility boxes, water meters, mailboxes, or other fixed objects. Items on PRIVATE PROPERTY will NOT be picked up.
