



2014 CITY OF PEORIA Historic Preservation Commission Awards

I. Purpose

The City of Peoria Historic Preservation Commission Awards program seeks to recognize the people, organizations, and programs that have helped to preserve Peoria's past. Awards may honor individual accomplishments, or may recognize an on-going commitment to preserving Peoria's history.

II. Eligible Award Recipients:

1. Individuals or organizations engaged in preserving Peoria's history.
2. Examples of eligible recipients include:
 - a. Individuals or organizations involved in history education, advocacy, or field work.
 - b. On-going programs that promote and/or preserve Peoria's history.
 - c. Projects that represent the successful preservation, restoration, or re-use of historic buildings or sites.

III. Nomination Requirements:

In order to be accepted for review nominations must include the following:

1. A completed Nomination form.

2. A type-written explanation of 500 words or less.

Describe the nominated individual, group, or organization and the activities, program, or project that has made a positive impact on the preservation of Peoria's heritage.

3. At least one color photograph.

Photographs may show the historic resources involved, the results of a project, people involved in a project or program, or community members benefiting from the activities, programs, or projects.

Additional documents may be provided (such as publications or news articles that describe the nominated persons, programs, or projects). **Individuals or organizations may nominate themselves and their own projects and programs.** Materials may be condensed for the Commission's review.

Photos and other nomination materials will not be returned to the applicant.

Examples of past award recipients:

- *Peoria Arizona Historical Society – For the salvage and reuse of the Peoria high school “Old Gym” Floor*
- *Pricilla Cook – Lifetime Achievement Award*
- *Save Old Main Committee – For their commitment to save Peoria's First High School, “Old Main” from demolition*

Nomination packages must be received by the Planning Division no later than **Monday, March 3, 2014**.

Nomination packages can be submitted by mail or dropped off with planning counter staff at the Development & Community Services Building, located at 9875 N. 85th Avenue, Peoria, AZ 85345. Nominations may also be submitted by email to melissa.sigmund@peoriaaz.gov

The Historic Preservation Commission will review and consider nominations at their regular meeting on **March 12, 2014**. The commission may choose to confer one or more awards depending on the nature of the nominations received.
