


63,717 non emergency

74,478 non emergency/  
administrative calls received last year

Including other calls, Communications  
processed 256,593 phone calls last year



# Communications



**Priority 1 Definition** A priority one call is any life-threatening call which involves the possibility of death or serious injury, any confrontation between two or more people that could threaten the life or safety of any person; or any call in which the delay in dispatch may compromise the immediate apprehension of a suspect.

**Average Response Time: 5:44**


