

What's it all about?

This June, the Peoria Police Department Police Activities League will be presenting the Youth Citizen's Police Academy to help build relationships with kids entering the 7th and 8th Grades.

This program is intended to introduce children entering junior high school to what the Peoria Police Department is all about. This program is FREE, all fees are paid for by the Peoria Police Department Police Activities League.

All participants will receive a t-shirt and certificate upon completion of the coursework. On the final day, students will tour the Police Station and have lunch.



Topics Covered

What will be taught at this Academy? The course work will be similar to our adult citizen's academy; however, for the kids, there will be more hands-on activities and more fun!

- Arrest Procedures/Defensive Tactics
- Physical Fitness

NOTE - Children will not shoot real firearms, but may handle demonstration weapons and will be able to operate a simulator used in police training.

Requirements

This Academy is open to all boys and girls entering 7th and 8th Grades in Fall 2012. Students must reside in Peoria or attend a school within the Peoria city limits. There is no academic requirement; however, good behavior is required at all times!

This is not a boot camp or program for rebellious teens.

This is a free program, which requires a parental / guardian permission slip and waiver.

Transportation to and from the school is to be provided by the parent / guardian. Transportation for Friday's visit to the police station will be provided by parent / guardian. Lunch (free) will be provided (only on Friday) while at the police station.

Physical Fitness and Team Building will be held on Wednesday's only at Rio Vista Recreation Center. Transportation for Wednesday will be provided by the parents .
