Criteria:

- All the residents' valuable property/jewelry has been secured/locked in a safe location or turned over to a family member.
- Facility management maintains logged accountability, control, and custody of all master keys.
- All facility employees, including cleaning and maintenance personnel, are required to complete/pass a background check.

Recommended Criteria:

- All valuable property/jewelry should be properly documented and photographed on the Crime Shield Property Inventory Record form or similar electronic/inventory document. Websites such as Knowyourstuff.org and whatyouown.org or Apps such as suresafe-home inventory or home inventory lite can also be used.
- High value items without serial numbers should have owner applied numbers (ex. - driver's license number, other identifiable number) **It is suggested not to use date of birth or social security numbers.**
- Video surveillance cameras should monitor all hallways, recording entry and exit of residential quarters.
- Facility staff should only be allowed in residential living quarters when resident is present.
- Electronic key entry is suggested to provide a control log and monitor access of residential quarters.
