**Prescription Drugs**

If you have a prescription medication, do not flush it down the toilet or drain. Instead, follow these guidelines from the federal Office of National Drug Control Policy:

Take drug(s) out of original container.

1. Mix drug(s) with an undesirable substance such as coffee grounds or kitty litter.
2. Put mixture in a nondescript container, such as an empty can with a lid or a sealable bag. This will help insure these drugs are not diverted or accidentally ingested by children or pets.
3. Place in your trash barrel under waste so that it is not visible.

The Prescription Drug Take-Back campaign will provide a safe way for Arizonans to dispose of their unwanted prescription drugs," said Acting DEA Special Agent in Charge, Doug Coleman. ### **Unsolicited Mail, Telemarketing and Email: Where to Go to "Just Say No"**

Tired of having your mailbox crammed with unsolicited mail, including preapproved credit card applications? Fed up with getting telemarketing calls just as you're sitting down to dinner? Fuming that your email inbox is chock-full of unsolicited advertising? The good news is that you can cut down on the number of unsolicited mailings, calls, and emails you receive by learning where to go to "just say no."

### **Credit and Insurance Offers - Opt Out through Consumer Reporting Companies**

If you decide that you don't want to receive prescreened offers of credit and insurance, you have two choices: You can opt out of receiving them for five years or opt out of receiving them permanently.

**To opt out for five years:** Call toll-free 1-888-5-OPT-OUT (1-888-567-8688) or visit [www.optoutprescreen.com](http://www.optoutprescreen.com). The phone number and website are operated by the major consumer reporting companies.

**To opt out permanently:** You may begin the permanent Opt-Out process online at [www.optoutprescreen.com](http://www.optoutprescreen.com). To complete your request, you must return the signed

Permanent Opt-Out Election form, which will be provided after you initiate your online request.

When you call or visit the website, you'll be asked to provide certain personal information, including your home telephone number, name, Social Security number, and date of birth. The information you provide is confidential and will be used only to process your request to opt out.

If you don't have access to the Internet, you may send a written request to permanently opt out to each of the major consumer reporting companies. Make sure your request includes your home telephone number, name, Social Security number, and date of birth.
