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## NEIGHBORHOOD GRANTS PROGRAM

### **“Traditional” Neighborhood Association Requirements**

1. Must be registered with the City of Peoria. An application can be found at the following link.
  - a. [www.peoriaaz.gov/Neighborhood/Neighborhood\\_HOA\\_Form.asp](http://www.peoriaaz.gov/Neighborhood/Neighborhood_HOA_Form.asp)
2. Must have a minimum of five (5) homes participating in project.
3. Clear boundaries of what defines your Neighborhood Association.
  - a. One home in the association includes the entire block (ex: 93xx W. Bluff Ln. will include at the minimum, Bluff Ln. from 93<sup>rd</sup> to 94<sup>th</sup> Avenues).
4. There must be a designated Neighborhood Association Leader.
5. Every home within the Neighborhood Association boundaries must have had an opportunity to participate.
  - a. If any homes are not participating, there must be three (3) documented attempts trying to involve them.
  - b. Each homeowner participating will be required to submit a written description of what improvement will occur on their property.
6. The Neighborhood Association is encouraged to register for Block Watch Program with the City of Peoria.
7. Improvements to individual properties is external and must be visible to the entire neighborhood. Ex: painting, xeriscaping.
8. Improvements to individual properties cannot add an additional feature that improves one property over another. Ex: water fountain, addition of decorative wall, etc.
