


# ADAPTIVE SUMMER PROGRAM



## Come Join the Fun!

The City of Peoria Adaptive Recreation program offers three programs during the summer for those with support from the Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD.) The sites are staffed on a 1:4 staff ratio and practice a recreational/leisure based model.

Ages 6-11 years old can participate in an inclusive summer recreation program site. Due to the number of kids in this setting, those interested must be able to process loud noises and multiple activities occurring at the same time.

For those who are between the ages of 12-17 and 18-22 can participate in one of our two self-contained high school programs.

All programs use DTS hours assigned to the participants through DDD and parents/guardians need to speak with their Support Coordinator as well.
