

Dear Summer Camp Parents,

Wednesday June 11,2014 we are offering a trip to Wet N Wild water park. Below is some important information regarding this trip. If you want your child to attend this trip, please sign the release below and return to the camp staff by **Monday, June 9th**. **Your child will not be allowed to attend trip without your signature on this form.**

We would recommend this trip for children age 8 and older. If you choose to allow your younger child to attend we will assign your child along with some other children to a specific leader for the day. These participants will remain with this staff person for the duration of the trip.

The staff will go over several items with the children prior to leaving on the trip. They will mention:

1. Departure/return time
2. How, when and where lunch is served.
3. The location of water faucets, restrooms, and first aid stations
4. Tell the children to listen for announcements for lunch and departure
5. A leader is always stationed at meeting area and at the entrance /exit gate.
6. All staff have on their blue or red staff shirts and can ask for help from any of them.
7. We will have several sunscreen and water breaks throughout the day. It is important that sunscreen be applied and everyone drinks plenty of water to avoid dehydration.

The bus will depart from the site no later than 9:15 am and will return no later than 4:30 pm. The children will be served a lunch (hamburger/chips/drink) at Wet n Wild between the times of 11:30 am and 1:00 pm and staff will be sure your child has gone through the line. Each site will designate a meeting place where a staff person will remain at all times with towels, bags etc. We strongly suggest that you apply sunscreen before your child arrives at site.

We have the following safety features in place:

- A staff person will be stationed at the exit gate throughout the day
- We will maintain a staff ratio of 1 leader to 20 participants.
- All Participants will need to stay with a staff person at all times thorough out the day.
- Cups and coolers with water will be provided on all buses.
- The meeting place will be marked with a large sign.
- All camp participants will wear wristbands that have City of Peoria information.

We want your child to have a fun and safe experience at Wet n Wild. Parents, you are more than welcome to meet us at Wet n Wild and spend the day with us.
