

ORDINANCE NO. 2011- 26

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PEORIA MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, ARIZONA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2010-33 BY REPEALING SECTION 9 OF THE ORDINANCE IN ITS ENTIRETY; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THEREFORE, it is ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Peoria as follows:

SECTION 1. The provisions of Section 9 of Ordinance No. 2010-33 are retroactively repealed as of November 30, 2011. Section 9 of Ordinance No. 2010-33 read as follows: ~~The provisions of this ordinance shall automatically terminate on November 30, 2011.~~

SECTION 10. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 11. The Council having declared an emergency and that it is necessary to preserve the public health, safety and welfare, therefore, this ordinance shall become effective immediately.
