

ARTICLE II. THE COUNCIL

Sec. 4. Terms of mayor.

A. The mayor shall be elected for a term of four (4) years and serve until his successor is elected and qualified. No person shall be eligible to succeed themselves in the office of mayor for more than two (2) consecutive terms, but there shall be no limit on the number of nonconsecutive terms.

B. In the event a person serves as Mayor for more than two years of a term that some other person is elected for, such portion of the term shall count as one term for purposes of the term limit set forth in subsection A.
