

CHAPTER 3 – ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Sec. 3-3. Alcoholic beverages; temporary or permanent extension of licensed premises.

(a) The City may consider the following factors in reviewing an application for a temporary or permanent extension of licensed premises:

- (1) Criminal history of the applicant.
- (2) Nature of the event.
- (3) Security measures taken by the applicant.
- (4) Type of alcohol that will be sold at the event.
- (5) How the alcohol will be served.
- (6) Whether the promoter of the event has obtained special events licenses in the City of Peoria within the last three years that have created neighborhood disturbances.
- (7) Potential for problems in the neighborhood of the proposed event in terms of noise, hours, and time of day.
- (8) Length of the event.
- (9) Restroom facilities available to the participants.
- (10) Whether the zoning and land use requirements are proper.
- (11) Anticipated number of attendees
- (12) The nature of the sound application systems.

(b) The city manager or his designee is authorized to approve or disapprove a temporary or permanent extension of licensed premises in accordance with the provisions of subsection (a). The city manager as he deems appropriate shall report to the city council on the special event licenses issued under this section.
