

CHAPTER 6 - CABLE COMMUNICATION SYSTEMS

Sec. 6-80. Reports.

(a) Each year the Licensee shall brief the offices of the City Manager, no later than one hundred twenty (120) days after the end of the Licensee's fiscal year. The briefing shall include a description of all major activities applicable to its operation during the preceding twelve (12) month period. At the briefing, Licensee shall submit a written report that includes the following information, specific to the City: number of homes passed, number of cable plant miles, number of Subscribers for each type of Cable Service offered and the Gross Revenues from each source attributable to the operations of Licensee from within the City. This report shall be verified as being correct by an officer of the company. There shall be submitted along with this report such other information reasonably related to License compliance as the City shall reasonably request.

(b) Upon request, there shall be provided to the City, copies of any communications and reports submitted by Licensee to the Federal Communications Commission or any other federal or state regulatory commission or agency having jurisdiction in respect to any manners affecting construction or operation of a Cable System in the City.

(c) Licensee shall provide the City with regular reports, as needed, to establish Licensee's compliance with the various standards and other provisions of this Chapter.
