

## CHAPTER 9 – FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION

### Sec. 9-52. Fireworks; penalty.

The penalty for violating any prohibition or requirement imposed by Sections 9-46 through 9-53 is a class two misdemeanor and is punishable by a fine not to exceed seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) or jail time not to exceed four (4) months, unless another penalty is specifically provided for under this code or state statute.
