

CHAPTER 11 – LICENSES, TAXATION AND MISCELLANEOUS
BUSINESS REGULATONS

Sec. 11-160. Special Events Business License; required; revocation.

(a) The provisions of this section shall apply to any person meeting all of the following requirements.

- (1) Engages in any businesses, callings, or professions within the corporate limits of the city or who conducts a business outside the corporate limits of the city and who solicits, canvasses, advertises, or delivers products or performs services within the city limits; and
- (2) Conducts such businesses callings or professions for a period of not more than seven (7) consecutive days at any one time.

The applicant shall procure from the Management Services Director or his designee a license for the carrying on of same upon payment of the required application fee. Upon completion of the license period, a sales tax return for the entire licensing period shall be filed within twenty (20) business days. Once the sales tax return is filed and all taxes paid, the license is terminated.

Special Event Business Licenses issued pursuant to the provisions of this section may be revoked by the Management Service Director, upon written notice to the licensee for any violation of this chapter or any other code, rule or regulation of the City. An appeal of such revocation shall be made in the manner provided by this Chapter.
