

CHAPTER 11 – LICENSES, TAXATION AND MISCELLANEOUS
BUSINESS REGULATONS

Sec. 11-161. Business Licenses, Special Event Business License, Other Licenses; failure to obtain, violation; classification; civil penalties.

(a) It is unlawful for any person, entity or corporation to fail to obtain a business license, special event business license, any other license required by this chapter or a transaction privilege tax license from the City.

(b) Violation of this section shall be a class (1) misdemeanor.

(c) The City shall impose a civil penalty of an amount equal to three (3) times the applicable license fee that shall be charged to any individual at the time of application for a license pursuant to this code. Such civil penalty shall not be part of any penalty imposed upon conviction of a criminal violation of this chapter. Such civil penalty may be appealed in the same manner as a license revocation under this chapter.
