

CHAPTER 13 – MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS AND OFFENSES

Sec. 13-59. Body Piercing; minors; violations; classification; definition

(a) It is unlawful to body pierce a person who is under eighteen years of age without the consent of and physical presence of that person's parent or legal guardian.

(b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a class 1 Misdemeanor.

(c) For the purpose of this section, "body pierce" means cutting, injection, poking or insertion of instruments upon or under the skin for the purpose of attaching earrings, rings, jewelry jeweled studs or any other metallic or plastic object for the purpose of wearing such object.
