

CHAPTER 13 – MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS AND OFFENSES

Sec. 13-60 Body Piercing: misrepresentation of age.

(a) It is unlawful for a person who is under eighteen years of age to misrepresent their age to any person by means of a written instrument of identification with the intent to induce a person to perform body piercing as defined in Section 13-59 of this code.

(b) It is unlawful for a person who is under eighteen years of age to use a fraudulent or false written instrument to obtain body piercing as defined in Section 13-59 of this code.

(c) It is unlawful for a person who knowingly influences the performing of body piercing as defined in Section 13-59 of this code by misrepresenting the age of or the familiar status with such person.

(d) A person who violates this section is guilty of a class 1 misdemeanor.
