

CHAPTER 13 – MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS AND OFFENSES

Sec. 13-67. Aggressive Solicitation; construction and severability.

(a) Severability is intended throughout and within the provisions of the Ordinance. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional by a court to competent jurisdiction, then such judgment shall in no way affect or impair the validity of the remaining portions of sections 13-64 through 13-67.

(b) Sections 13-64 through 13-67 of this code are not intended to proscribe any demand for payment for services rendered or goods delivered.

(c) Sections 13-64 through 13-67 of this code are not intended to create a result through enforcement that is absurd, impossible or unreasonable. Sections 13-64 through 13-67 of this code should be held inapplicable in any such cases where its application would be unconstitutional under the Constitution of the State of Arizona or the Constitution of the United States.
