

CHAPTER 14 - MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

Sec. 14-102. Authority to erect signs; violations.

(a) The Engineering Director shall establish and the public works director or his designee is authorized to erect signs to restrict or limit parking on any street, roadway, right of way, city, property or facilities, park or other property of the city in accordance with the provisions of this section.

(1) The engineering director may establish certain time zones on any street, roadway, right of way, city property or facilities, during which parking may be limited to certain time limits or prohibited.

(b) It shall be unlawful to stop, stand or park any motor vehicle in violation of any sign erected by the public works director or his designee pursuant to subsection (a). Violation of this section shall be designated a civil traffic violation and shall be punished by imposition of a civil sanction.
