

CHAPTER 20 - PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

Sec. 20-205. Floodplain management; coordination.

The City may adopt other regulations which provide for coordination with all other interested and affected political subdivisions and state agencies and may enter into agreements for cooperative regulations, planning, designs, and construction. The Engineering Director shall advise the Flood Control District of Maricopa County and any other adjacent jurisdiction having responsibility for floodplain management, in writing, and provide a copy of any development plan of floodplain or floodway within one mile of the boundary between the City's area of jurisdiction and the area of jurisdiction of the District. The Engineering Director shall also advise the District and any adjacent jurisdiction having responsibility for floodplain management in writing and provide a copy of any development plan of any major development proposed within a floodplain or a floodway which could affect floodplains, floodways or watercourses outside the City's area of jurisdiction. Written notice and a copy of the plan of development shall be sent to any adjacent jurisdiction no later than three working days after having been received.
